We now offer electronic prescribing; patients need to sign a consent form with the chemist they wish to nominate.

Telephone Numbers / Change of Address & email contact details

Patients are reminded to update our reception with their change of address/telephone numbers & email details. We sometimes have difficulties contacting patients where telephone numbers are unobtainable and addresses have changed.

Cancelling appointments.

The Practice has a strict DNA policy. It is appreciated that occasionally patients are unable to keep their appointment with the nurse or doctor. However it is extremely important that the surgery is notified as far in advance as possible so that another patient can be offered an appointment. All patients who do

not attend an appointment will be contacted by letter advising them of our DNA policy

Blood Tests

We now have a Phlebotomy clinic on Wednesday and Thursday mornings

Appointments must be pre booked, show receptionist blood form when booking appointment and ensure you bring the form on the day to avoid being sent away.

Touch Screen booking in system:

We have a touch screen booking in system and kindly ask all patients to book themselves in on arrival at the surgery- you can book in 20 minutes before your appointment time. We encourage you to use the touch screen to confirm we have the correct contact details etc for you

Vascular Clinics

Heart MOT for vascular check-up: please book an appointment if you are 40-74 to have your heart MOT, please inform reception this is what your appointment is for as it must be booked into a vascular clinic.

Chronic Disease Management patients receiving medication for high blood pressure, asthma, cholesterol, heart disease, diabetes, strokes and chronic kidney disease should be seen at least 6-12 monthly to ensure they remain on the best treatment for current symptoms. Please book an appointment with the Practice Nurse . Patients receiving long term treatment for hypothyroidism and epilepsy should have blood levels checked prior to yearly review.

Letters, passport signing and form completion.

You must have been registered with the practice for a minimum of 2 yrs.

Patients are advised that the charge for these requests has increased to £20. Note: **There are NO exceptions**

Chlamydia

We offer a **free confidential** service for all 16-25 year olds for Chlamydia screening. Please ask at reception or when seeing a clinician

Holiday Vaccinations

We are a designated yellow fever centre and are able to offer all patients not just those registered at the surgery a yellow fever vaccination. The charge for this is £50.00 per person vaccinated.

Meningococcal Meningitis Vaccine – the charge for this vaccine is £50 per person vaccinated

Baby Clinic –

1st & 3rd Wednesdays of each month 1.30-3.30pm

Please ask at reception if you would like your child to receive his/her immunisations during baby clinic.

- **Practice Nurses Vongai & Alice** : are able to see patients for the following:
- Asthma, Diabetes(Vongai only)
- Sexual health concerns
- Emergency contraception/contraceptive advice.
- Smear Tests Travel health
- Wound care
- Contraception; repeats of OCP, depot.(contraceptives need to be started by Nurse Vongai or a doctor , then can be repeated by either nurse)
- Ear care e.g. ear syringing
- New patient health checks.
- BP checks
- Flu Vaccines
- Smoking Cessation
- Heart MOT (vascular clinic)
